CONVENTION INFORMATION

The Hilton at the Ballpark is located in the heart of downtown St. Louis, a mere 100 yards from Busch Stadium and footsteps from the Gateway Arch and many area attractions. The hotel is 14 miles from the St. Louis International Airport and easily accessible from all major interstates. Ground transportation to the hotel is available via, Metro Light Rail, or shuttle with Go Best Express. Rates and details are below. The Hilton features the Three Sixty Rooftop Bar, Market Street Bistro, Imo's Pizza, YoMy Goodness, and Starbucks. Other hotel amenities include an indoor pool, fitness center, ATM, concierge, gift and snack shop, safety deposit box, and room service. For those driving to St. Louis, the current daily self-park rate is \$16.00.

Please note that due to the possibility of Cardinal Baseball, extra nights will need to be booked very early and guaranteed with a credit card. **Deadline dates will be strictly enforced. We have no choice in this matter. Sorry, but you snooze and you lose.**

CHILDREN AT CONVENTION

Children are welcome at the convention. Those 16 and under stay for free in the room with their parents, and they must use the beds that are in their room. A charge of \$175.00 US funds will be charged for each child. This fee includes Friday and Saturday dinners, Saturday and Sunday breakfasts, and a welcome package. Remember, children are allowed in the banquet rooms for meals and to hear any speeches, but when dancing begins, they must leave. It is the parent's responsibility for the conduct of their children at all times. If they become a distraction by interrupting any guest speaker or interfering with any hotel or convention staff member, they will be asked to leave whatever room they are in. No person under the age of 21 shall be allowed into any hospitality room while alcohol is served.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

There are several methods of transportation from Lambert St. Louis International airport to the hotel. Metro Light Rail tickets are available for purchase in the airport. A one-way ticket is approximately \$3.75. The Busch Stadium stop is just 1 block from the hotel. Taxis are available from either terminal for about \$40 one-way. We have also arranged a special rate for shuttle service via Go Best Express. One-way transportation is \$17 or roundtrip is \$32 per person (fuel surcharges may apply). PRE-CONVENTION ACTIVITIES

We hope that you will explore and enjoy the many local attractions that are in close proximity to our hotel such as the Gateway Arch, City Garden Park, City Museum, Eugene Field House and Toy Museum and the Lumiere Casino. Our Committee is happy to assist you in planning a journey on your own to an area attraction, just let us know your interest.

Following are the pre-convention trips that will be offered. Due to the rising cost of fuel, we reserve the right to add a fuel surcharge to the price of each trip should the price of diesel fuel rise significantly. Please note the Sneaker Level on each trip. The Sneaker Level illustrates the highest level of activity on any given tour.

1 Sneaker – easy pace, mostly ramps with little incline and less than a flight of steps.

2 Sneakers – ability to walk at moderate pace, climb one flight of stairs or up and down an incline.

3 Sneakers – steady pace up to 30 minutes, easily navigate stairs and inclines.

4 Sneakers – indicates a strenuous activity, ability to move over uneven terrain for longer period of time, more than 1 flight of stairs.

MONDAY, AUGUST 4, 2014

Sipping and Spelunking ***All Day Trip 8:30 am to 5:00 pm*** ***Sneaker Level 3*** ***Cost: \$90.00***

Explore Missouri's wine and cave country along Route 66. Today travel west on Route 66 to the coolest place for a tour in the summer, the well-known Meramec Caverns. This cave has been a parking lot to school buses and motorcoaches and can host a party of up to 1,000 guests in its cool confines beneath the ground. Enjoy a full walking tour of this famous Missouri landmark that has been touted on many a farmer's barn roof and hear the stories of the past and present. After the tour we will be heading to Defiance, Missouri's Wine Country. Our lunch stop will be at Wine Country Gardens. Experience a lunch at a nursery that grew into a winery. The greenhouses greet you upon arrival and then you walk into the beautiful building where we will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch. While enjoying lunch you will be able to take turns at the tasting bar as three tastes are included per person. Find something you like and enjoy for lunch or bring some home! Our final stop will be Sugar Creek Winery. Enjoy this winery that feels more like a home than a business with its cozy nooks while tasting delicious Missouri wines.

Pianos and Pastries ***Half Day Trip 10:00 am to 4:00 pm*** ***Sneaker Level 1*** ***Cost: \$60.00***

Scott Joplin House, Delmar Loop, Jilly's Cupcakes. Explore the history around ragtime's beginnings at Scott Joplin's Home on Delmar Boulevard. Joplin lived in St. Louis for 18 months during the time period of the 1904 world's Fair and the rooming house he lived in has been preserved and is part of the Missouri State Parks System. You will enjoy a film about Joplin's life, tour the home and then someone will be chosen to pump the player piano to make the roll containing one of Joplin's famous tunes turn and create beautiful music. Reboard the coach and get a sightseeing tour of St. Louis en route to University City for lunch on your own at the Delmar Loop. This street is where the St. Louis street cars looped around and was one of the busiest places during that era. The last street car ceased to run in 1966. After a downturn of the neighborhood, visionary Joe Edwards saw the potential to bring this neighborhood back to its former glory while adding a lot of hip twists. Blueberry Hill is the restaurant he opened where Chuck Berry still performs throughout the year. Another local favorite for dining is Fitz's Rootbeer. Your tour guide will point out the St. Louis Walk of Fame along the sidewalk as well as the planetary walk. After lunch enjoy a visit to Jilly's Cupcakes, Food Network's Cupcake Wars winner in June 2011. Jilly's was the first St. Louis based business from the state of Missouri to win! The episode was titled "The Final Frontier", an outer space theme where bakers competed to have their tasty treats front & center at a VIP party honoring the first man in space. The winner was Jilly's banana toffee cupcakes. Today you will be given a demo on cupcake making and then get to decorate your own cupcake to eat on the spot or take home!

TUESDAY, AUGUST 5, 2014

Mark Twain's Hometown All Day Trip 7:30 am to 6:30 pm Sneaker Level 2 cost: \$120.00

Board the motorcoach for a 2 hour ride up the Blues Highway, Saints Avenue, US61, to Hannibal, Missouri, the home of America's most recognized author, Mark Twain. Upon arrival you will explore the newly renovated Mark Twain Museum with its 17 ORIGINAL Norman Rockwell prints, a bell from a steamboat (you can ring it too), a sternwheeler and much more. History comes alive as you walk through his boyhood home and learn of his humble beginnings in Florida, MO and then moving to Hannibal where his father was a Justice of the Peace. Enjoy a delicious lunch of baked chicken and roast beef aboard the Mark Twain Riverboat along with the company of our special guest, Mark Twain. Richard Garey has portrayed the legendary author all across the United States. He has written a book about Mark Twain and used his training as an actor to master the voice and cadence of Mark Twain's speech. He will answer questions you may have for Missouri's native son. Next, tour Rockcliffe Mansion and learn the lifestyle of the "Haves" of Hannibal who made their money from running, captaining or piloting steamboats during the 1800's. On your return through Missouri's Little Dixie we will stop in Champ Clark's hometown of Bowling Green, MO to enjoy a little chocolate at Bankhead's Chocolates. Each person will take home an original turtle chocolate. Champ Clark was Missouri's only Speaker to the US House of Representatives from 1911-1918. Return to St. Louis with wonderful memories of America's Hometown.

61 Roadhouse & The Peabody Half Day Trip 11:30 am to 4:00 pm Sneaker Level 1 Cost: \$55.00

Enjoy lunch at 61 Roadhouse, a St. Louis landmark dedicated to the music and roadhouse food along the Blues Highway. You may have seen it on TV in Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives. Order from a limited menu showcasing their signature BBQ, Cornbread Soufflé and much more. Enjoy the murals along the wall and music being played while you dine. Then it is off to St. Louis' latest renovated theatre, The Peabody, formerly the Kiel Opera house where you will enjoy a behind the scenes tour of this beautiful building, both architecturally and acoustically. Stand on the stage with your guide and enjoy your moment in the spotlight.

Crusin' for a Brew Shuttle Evening Trip 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm Sneaker Level 1 Cost: \$25.00

Enjoy a taste of St. Louis own breweries. Stops include 6 Row Brewing, Four Hands, and Buffalo Brewing. Beer and dinner on your own while enjoying the company of fellow conventioners.
